

You, the HIRER are responsible whilst hiring this equipment to ensure that all possible steps are taken to avoid injury or damage to it. Please ensure that the following Safety Instructions and guides are followed: We strongly advise that you seek your own liability insurance if you are concerned about the cover this contract allows.

Bouncy Castle Hire

1. This unit has a height limit. Please ensure that no one taller than the walls of the inflatable is allowed to use it.
2. No food or drinks or gum to be allowed on or near the inflatable Bouncy Castle which will avoid choking and damage (Please note if the Inflatable is collected in a dirty condition or damaged then the person hiring it will incur a cleaning and, or repairing charge)
3. All footwear, glasses, jewellery, badges MUST be removed before using the Bouncing Castle.
4. No face paints, party poppers, streamers, silly string or ink based products to be used either on or near the Bouncy Castle.
5. No smoking or cooking equipment near the Bouncy Castle.
6. Important Climbing, hanging or sitting on walls is DANGEROUS and under no circumstances should this be allowed.
7. A responsible Adult must supervise the Bouncy Castle at all times. Alcohol or any other substance is forbidden whilst using or supervising the castle.
8. Make sure that the Bouncy Castle is not overcrowded, and limit numbers according to the age and size of Children using it. Try to avoid large and small Children from using it at the same time.
9. Prevent Horseplay, Please ensure Children are not pushing, colliding, fighting or behaving in a manner likely to injure or cause distress to others. Somersaults are strictly forbidden as these are very dangerous on this type of equipment.
10. If the Bouncing Inflatable Castle is not being used for any part of the day, please switch the blower off at the mains.
11. Do not allow anyone to bounce on the front safety step as a Child could easily bounce off the inflatable and get hurt. The step is there to assist users in getting on or off !
12. It is essential to ensure that no-one with a history of back or neck problems is allowed on the Bouncy Castle and also any Child who is feeling unwell.
13. Do not allow anyone to be on the Bouncy Castle during inflation or deflation as this is DANGEROUS.
14. No pets, toys or sharp instruments to be allowed on or near the Bouncy Castle.
15. Please ensure that Children are not attempting somersaults and are clothed appropriately and that nothing can fall out of their pockets.
16. Ensure that an area of 6 feet (2 meters) around the unit is completely clear. THE BLOWER SHOULD BE AT LEAST 1 METRE AWAY FROM THE BOUNCER.
17. The Bouncy Castle should not be used if it becomes wet on the jumping area. If no shower cover is fitted and in the event of rain, the unit should not be used
18. In the event of heavy rain, Please ensure that the bouncy castle is left up (all equipment is rated at least IP44). Any wetness, including bubbling (which is normal) can be dried with a towel.
19. In the event that the blower stops working, please ensure all users get off the inflatable immediately. Please make sure the blower tube or deflation tube has not come undone or something has not blown onto and is obstructing the blower. In the event that it overheats, or loses power, switch the blower off at the mains, then switch it back on again 1 or 2 minutes later, and it should restart. If it does not, inform us straight away.
20. If using petrol blower, the driver will show you how this works. You will be left with some extra petrol to ensure continued use. This petrol must be kept out of reach of children and away from direct heat source.
21. Please ensure that children are not allowed near the blower.
22. Any injuries must be reported to driver when the inflatable is collected, and an accident form will be completed with you. Accident forms will not be filled out after driver has collected and left your premises

Soft Play/ Ball Pool/ Toddler Roller Coaster/ Sensory Dome

1. Children must remove their shoes before using the soft play/ball pool. Food, Drinks, Glasses and pets are forbidden on all equipment.

2. Equipment Returned in a dirty condition will be subject to a cleaning charge of a minimum of £10. No children who have been face painted can use the equipment due to the make up staining, and absolutely no streamers or silly string is permitted near the equipment.
3. 8 years is the maximum age limit for use on any of the soft play/ball pool
4. We request that the customer ensures that balls are kept in the ball pool throughout the hire period
5. No smoking or cooking equipment near the equipment.
6. Children to use the Toddler Roller Coaster as it was meant to be used (one child at a time, facing the right way and using the correct car ONLY)
7. Children to be supervised at all times whilst using the Toddler roller coaster, or any of the soft play/sensory equipment
8. Sensory toys to remain within the sensory dome at all times

Inflatable Race Track (Please refer to rules as laid out in "Bouncy Castle" section of agreement...

1. Children must be supervised at all times by an adult.
2. Children are not to bounce on the inflatable race track at any time. It is important that this does not happen as there are no mats in or around the race track.
3. One child per ride on/hopper (unless using tandem hopper)

I have read the above agreement and fully understand and accept the conditions as above. I am aware that whilst in my care I am fully responsible for the inflatable and will pay for any loss or damage that may occur, this will include the inflatable being returned in an unacceptable condition, i.e.: If it is in a dirty or muddy condition, I will be expected to pay an additional cleaning charge. I have checked with the operator that the inflatable bouncing castle, has been erected and secured properly.

We will also require a non-refundable booking fee, which is payment for holding the equipment for you, for a specific date, the paperwork involved in making this booking and the communication between our company and the hirer. This booking fee is completely non refundable, and should the hirer cancel their booking prior to the date of scheduled hire, or should we arrive at the property and find there to be insufficient space required to safely put up the equipment that is being hired, full payment is still required.

If the hirer was to cancel due to poor weather conditions, then the £20 booking fee may be transferred over to another date, as long as this booking is made within 4 weeks of the cancelled booking. WE WILL NOT PUT UP ANY BOUNCY CASTLES IF OUR ANEMOMETER MEASURES OVER 24MPH... this is due to health and safety rules.
